This showcase is designed to provide the opportunity for creative musicians - composers to have their works performed in the best concert halls of New York City.

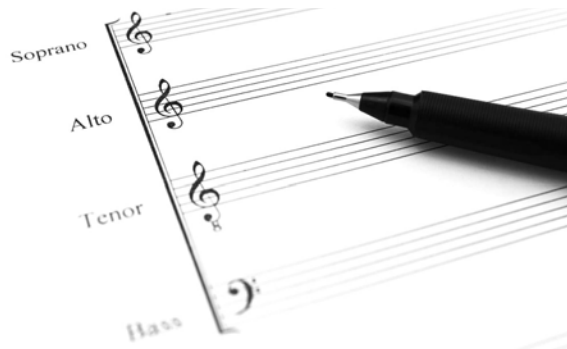
- **GRAND PRIX** winners will perform at Weill Recital Hall at Carnegie Hall
