Application Deadline: February 3, 2014



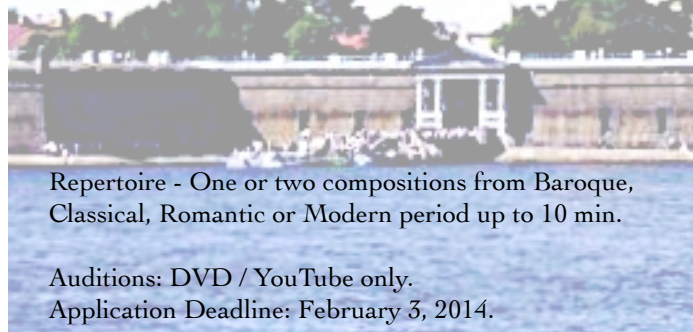
